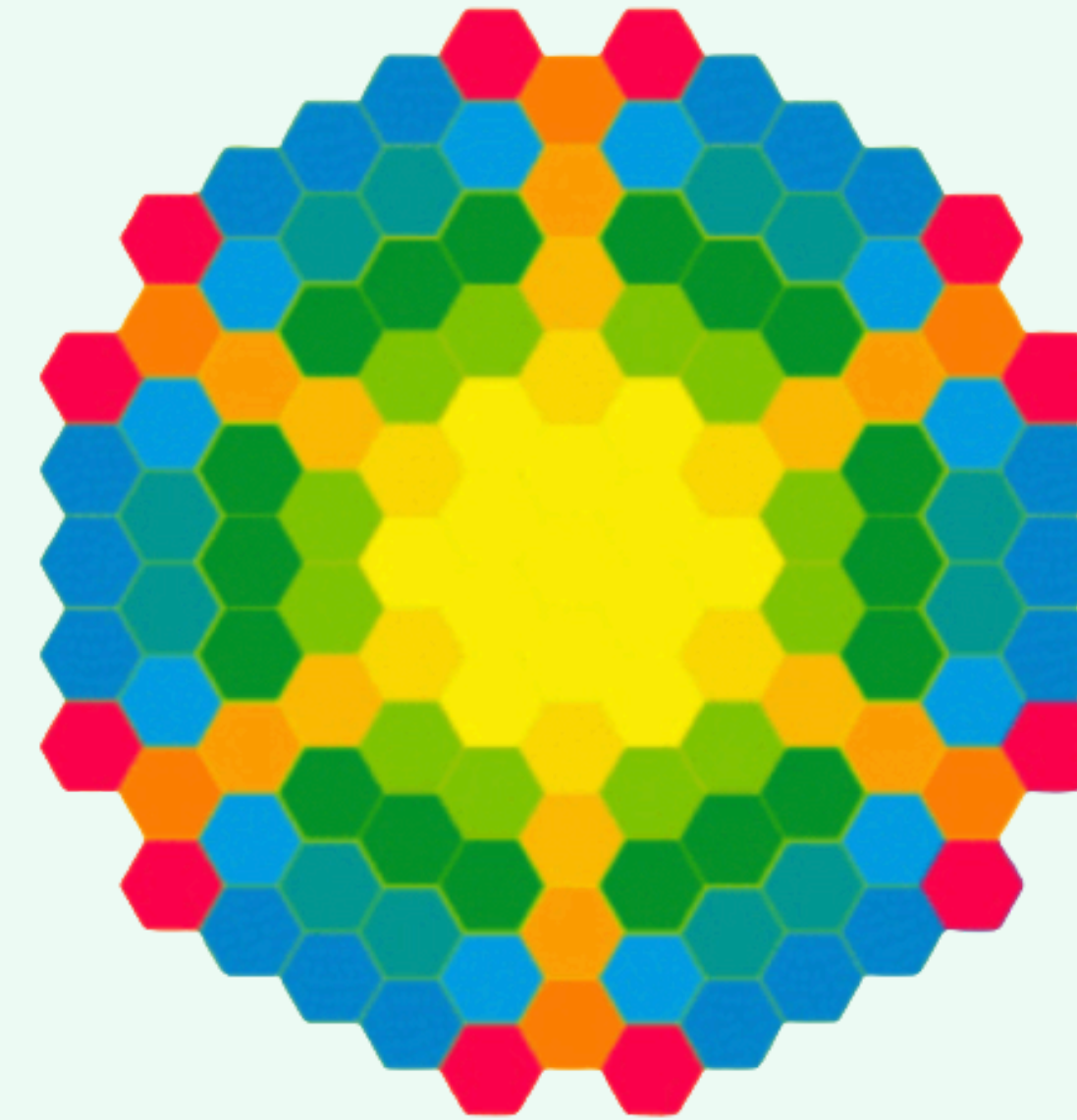

RCCF - Arteale Transformation Proposal

- Seeking independent funding from the private sector
- Governance innovation (Somos Stewards)
- Central coordination with local actors: City Councils, Local Action Groups (LAGs), associations, businesses, cultural entities, etc.
- A scalable and successfully tested methodology
- Community capacity-building program

In a rural context, this model is particularly powerful because:

- It does not depend on public subsidies.
- **Generates its own resources within the territory.**
- Enables solutions tailored to each town/region.
- Has a long-term vision (not one-off projects).
- Can serve as a model for international scaling.

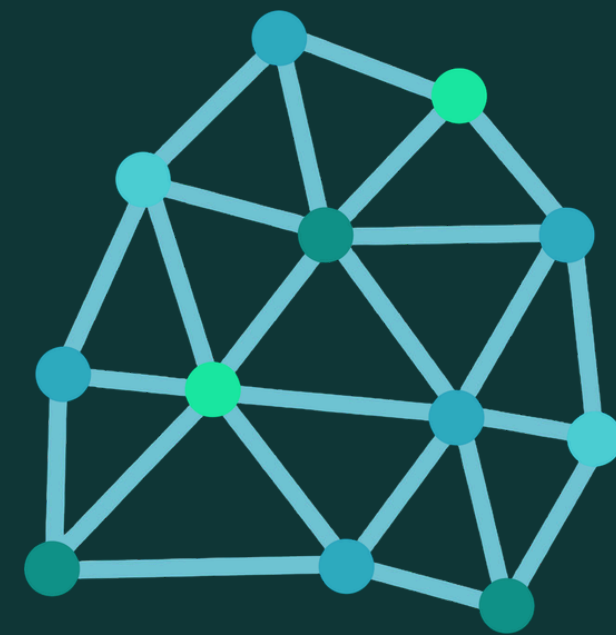
